Opening Times.

**The building will open from 9.30am Saturday 23 October
Screening starts at 11.15am**

It is worth getting here a bit early to set up your stuff, so that you're not searching for a place as Laura's body is being discovered!

A full schedule of episodes and breaks can be seen at the bottom of this document, but the main dinner break between 7 and 9.30pm on Saturday is when a lot of the other activities will be happening (although a lot of stuff will be going on throughout the night).

Seating

So if you have a balcony tickets your seats are all ready for you up there, they are unreserved so it will be first come first serve.

If you have a ticket for downstairs then you will need to bring your own seating. So bring anything to make you comfortable for this epic Lynchathon but **PLEASE** be considerate to people behind you. Bring duvets, cushions & padding but please don't bring any chairs or high bean bags or anything that will block the view of people behind you. I'm bringing two duvets to lie on and pillows to prop up my head, I think I can spend 32 hours like that.

Food and Drink

We are **not** allowing food and drink to be brought into the building but we have plenty of amazing food available inside.

You should have all received the Double R Diner's menu that was sent through last week but if not look at the bottom of this document. The Lynch Lunch Bags will be a very good way of buying food before the rush and avoiding wasting your time in any queues.

You can buy any item off the menu before the event by calling the Box Office on 020 7223 2223. We will give you a voucher for your food when you enter (good to do if you want to avoid the queues and not miss any of the screening or other events). Food will be served throughout the weekend so there will be plenty of stuff to eat.

Drinks

We have two bars at BAC, one up in the café and one by the Grand Hall where the screening will be.

The Café Bar opening hours – Sat 9.30am – 11pm. Sun 7.30am – 5pm

The Grand Hall Bar – Sat 1.30pm – 2am. Sun 12pm – 8pm

Both these bars will serve a wide range of drinks.

There will be coffee and snacks available throughout the whole event.

Bottomless coffee

Thanks to Café Direct we can keep everyone wired all weekend with bottomless coffee. Buy one of our *I Survived the Lynch Lock In* mugs (£5) and get endless refills whenever you like throughout the whole weekend.

Entrance and around the building

When you enter the building you will be given a wrist band and you will be able to come and go as you like, as long as you have your wrist band you will be re-admitted. But everything you will need will be in the building so I say be hard core and see if you can last for the whole weekend!

Twin Peaks Gazette

When you enter the building everyone will get a copy of the Twin Peaks Gazette when they enter which has details of all the other events that are happening over the weekend. It also has maps for the building and a complete schedule for the screening.
